Welcome to the second workshop on High-Performance, Power-Aware Computing.

We are very excited to be holding this event a second time. As we noted last year, power management is of great importance high-performance computing. This importance has not diminished in the last year. In fact, many important conferences—such as SC—2005, IPDPS, and PPoPP—presented several papers on power management. Industry interest in high-performance, power-aware computing is also increasing.
