SIGGRAPH '92 in Chicago

SIGGRAPH is the biggest event of the year for everyone concerned with computer graphics. It includes an extensive conference program, an exhibit area, and a theater and art show for showing off computer graphics work. The event fills the week from July 27–31, with tutorial courses Monday and Tuesday, the exhibition Tuesday through Thursday, and technical papers and panels Wednesday through Friday. Courses range from *Graphic Design for User Interfaces* to *Advanced Techniques in Human Modeling, Animation, and Rendering* and *Video Technology for Computer Graphics*. Panels will address a similarly wide range of subjects, including graphics standards, multimedia systems, and compression technology.

Full-day courses cost \$390; half-day courses are \$275. Registration for the technical papers and panels is \$525. Discounts are available for ACM members and students. Exhibition registration is free if requested be-
